DESCRIPTION OF WORK: Provides support services for the Family Planning Program, Maternal Health Program, General Services and the STD Program. Provides Diabetes Care Management education to patients that are referred from local providers.

QUALIFICATIONS: Knowledge and ability to apply the principles and practices of Public Health. General knowledge of current social and economic and behavioral problems and their treatment. Knowledge of governmental and private organizations and community resources. Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with administrative superiors, civic, medical, social and religious organizations. Ability to plan and coordinate day to day activities and to deal tactfully with others and to exercise good judgment in apprising situations and making decisions.
