

Scotland County Water District

Water Conservation Incentive Ordinance

Whereas, the Scotland County Water Districts recognizes that water is not an inexhaustible resource; and

Whereas, it is desirable to encourage residents of the Scotland County Water District to conserve water and reduce impacts to water supply sources and the existing wastewater treatment system;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED:

This ordinance shall be known as the Scotland County Water District Conservation Incentive Ordinance.

To help encourage water conservation, the Scotland County Water Districts will allow a one-time reduction of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) of the County water bill for any business or home that demonstrates the installation of low-flow toilet(s), low-flow shower head(s), or low-flow faucet(s).

To qualify for the Fifteen Dollar (\$15.00) reduction of the County water bill, the home or business owner shall provide proof of installation to the County Inspection Department. Proof of installation shall be in the form of a signed letter from a licensed plumber or contractor who completed the installation. The homeowner shall provide copies of receipts showing purchase date, purchase price, and place purchased for the low-flow device(s). Information regarding the brand and model of the fixtures installed shall also be provided. The Scotland County Water Districts shall have the authority to enter the premises and verify that the low-flow device has been installed. The County will verify installation of low-flow device, as it deems necessary.

The Fifteen Dollar (\$15.00) reduction of the County water bill shall be a one-time offer. The Fifteen Dollar (\$15.00) reduction of the County water bill is a maximum reduction and will be applied once, regardless of the number of low-flow devices installed. The credit will be applied to the bill after evidence satisfactory to the County to show proof of installation has been provided to the County.

This ordinance enacted this the 17 day of Oct., 2002.
