

**NOTICE OF GENERAL ELECTION
SCOTLAND COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA**

The statewide general election will be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2022.

Polls will be open from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Election Day.

One-stop early voting will be held at the following location from Thursday, October 20, 2022, to Saturday, November 5, 2022 during the times listed below:

- County Board of Elections Conference Room, 231 East Cronly Street, Laurinburg, NC
- October 20 – November 4, 2022 (Weekdays Only) 8am to 7:30pm
- November 5, 2022 (Saturday) 8am to 3:00pm

Absentee ballots will be mailed to voters who have requested them beginning September 9, 2022. A voter can fill out an absentee ballot request at votebymail.ncsbe.gov, or by filling out a request form provided by the county board of elections. The request must be received through the website or by the Scotland Board of Elections by 5 p.m. November 1, 2022.

In the general election, voters will select candidates for **U.S. Senate, U.S. House of Representatives, N.C. General Assembly, state and local judges, district attorney, and county offices.**

The voter registration deadline for this election is 5 p.m. Friday, October 14, 2022. Eligible individuals who are not registered by that deadline may register and vote at any early voting site during the early voting period. New registrants will be required to provide documentation of their residence.
