

**NOTICE OF ELECTION  
SCOTLAND COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA**

The municipal general election for Gibson, Laurinburg, Maxton and Wagram will be held on Tuesday, November 7, 2023.

**Voters will be asked to show photo ID when they vote.** All voters will be allowed to vote with or without ID. Voters who lack ID can get one for free from their county board of elections. Find out more at [ncsbe.gov/voter-id](https://ncsbe.gov/voter-id).

Polls will be open from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Election Day.

One-stop early voting will be held at the Scotland County Board of Elections Conference Room from Thursday, October 19, 2023, to Saturday, November 4, 2023. The voting hours will be Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm and Saturday, November 4, 2023 from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm. Canvass will be held in the Scotland County Board of Elections office at 11:00 a.m. on Friday, November 17, 2023.

Absentee ballots will be mailed to voters who have requested them beginning October 6, 2023 for Laurinburg and Maxton citizens only. Gibson and Wagram will not be offering absentee by-mail for this election. A voter can fill out an absentee ballot request at [votebymail.ncsbe.gov](https://votebymail.ncsbe.gov), or by filling out a request form provided by the board of elections. The request must be received through the website or by the Scotland County Board of Elections office by 5 p.m. October 31, 2023.

Registered voters who live within the boundaries of Gibson, Laurinburg, Maxton and Wagram may vote in the municipal election. Municipal contests include the mayor and members of the municipality's governing board.

The voter registration deadline for this election is 5 p.m. Friday, October 13, 2023. Eligible individuals who are not registered by that deadline may register and vote at any early voting site during the early voting period. New registrants will be required to provide documentation of their residence.
