USER REGISTRATION GUIDE

Follow these step-by-step instructions to create a Smart 911 profile and sign up for the new Scotland Alerts notification system.

1. Navigate your web browser to the following link:

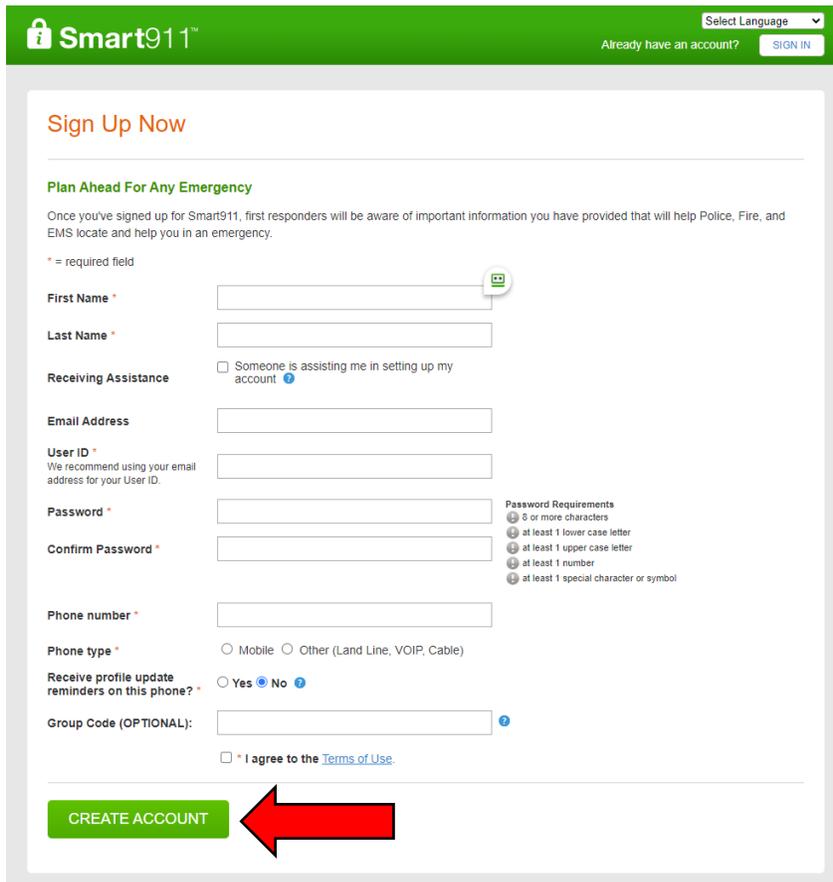

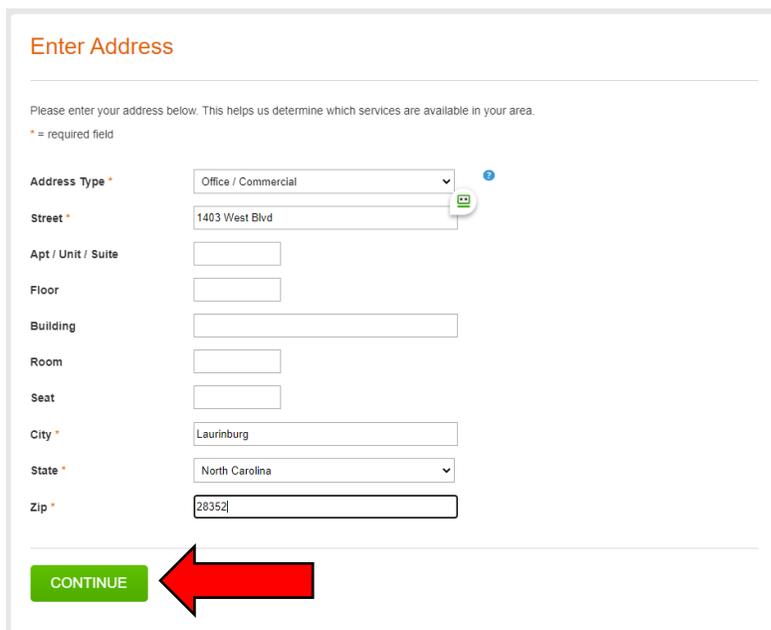

3. Enter the required information (denoted by an asterisk*), and include an email address if you would like to receive alerts via email *and* phone. There is no “GROUP CODE” for that space - please disregard. Read the terms and conditions, check the agreement box, and click the “CREATE ACCOUNT” button.

4. Now you can begin setting up a user profile. Entering your primary addresses (home, work, etc.) will help ensure that urgent messages that are applicable to a certain geographic area reach you in a timely manner.

Your data can help emergency managers strengthen their plans for responding to and recovering from natural disasters or other emergencies. This can include identifying those that require extra help during an evacuation, or determining the type and quantity of supplies that should be kept on-hand.
-  **Share my Smart911 Profile when I dial 9-1-1.**
Your profile can deliver valuable information to 9-1-1 and first responders, such as medical conditions, address details, and emergency contacts. This information can save valuable time during an emergency.
