Dear Voter:

As the 2015 Maxton Municipal Election is fast approaching I need to make you aware of some election changes that will affect you for the said election. Due to your address you are a Scotland County resident that is eligible for the Maxton Municipal Election.

In past Maxton Municipal Elections I was able to transfer your data to the Robeson County Board of Elections and they would handle everything. Per the NC State Board of Elections this will be changing for the 2015 Election. You are still eligible to vote in the 2015 Maxton Municipal Elections and will be given three different options to choose from as to how you would like to cast your ballot. Your options are as follows:

- 1. Request an absentee ballot to be mailed to you. (Approved request form enclosed)**
- 2. Vote at Scotland County's One Stop Location – located at the Board of Elections Office, 231 East Cronly Street, Suite 305, Laurinburg, NC. (schedule enclosed)**

OR

- 3. Wait until Election Day and vote in your normal assigned precinct in Scotland County which is Precinct # 2 located at the Learning Center, 420 Stewartsville Road, Laurinburg, NC.**

I do realize this procedure is not what you are accustomed to and I would like to apologize in advance for any inconvenience this may cause. Fortunately, it is our job to make sure that all general statues and state laws are followed.
