

ORDINANCE # 13

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE SCOTLAND COUNTY  
HISTORIC PROPERTIES COMMISSION A PUBLIC AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, The Scotland County Board of Commissioners established and empowered the Scotland County Historic Properties Commission by a resolution adopted on June 15, 1976;

AND, WHEREAS, the General Assembly of North Carolina has amended North Carolina General Statute Section 159-7 (b) (10) to permit the Scotland County Historic Properties Commission to be a public authority when so designated by ordinance of the Scotland County Board of Commissioners;

AND, WHEREAS, the Scotland County Historic Properties Commission has requested that the Scotland County Board of Commissioners designate it a public authority;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SCOTLAND COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS:

1) "That effective July 1, 1979 the Scotland County Historic Properties Commission is designated a public authority as defined in North Carolina General Statute Section 159-7 (b) (10), as amended"; and,

2) That the Scotland County Manager is hereby authorized and directed to file a copy of this ordinance with the Local Government Commission.
